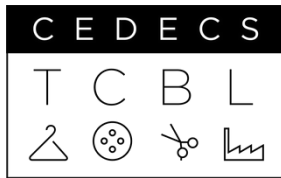

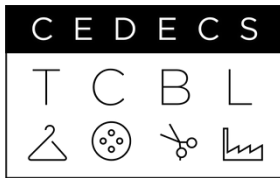
2. Purpose of the survey

The purpose of this survey is threefold:

- a) To identify you as a respondent and your organisation, if you list one
- b) To collect some additional information, if you register to become part of the Herewear community
- c) To gather your opinion on a number of issues, which are relevant to our research.



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3. Duration of the survey

This survey will be run continuously for the entire duration of the Herewear project, ie. until 30 September, 2024.

4. Gathered data

Making reference to par. 2 above "Purpose of the survey", depending on your decision, the following data may be gathered:

4a) To identify you as a respondent and your organisation, if you list one, by collecting

- Name and surname
- Country of residence
- Organisation name

This information will be published on the Herewear website listing you as a member of the Herewear Community, if you grant explicit consent for this purpose in the Survey itself, otherwise it will be used internally and never disclosed to any third party.

4b) To collect some additional information, if you register to become part of the Herewear community, namely

- Email address
- Herewear partner on-line services to which you are currently subscribed

This information will be used internally for profiling your interests and keeping you informed on the goals of the project, but never disclosed to anyone.

If you provide a special consent, the email address will be used by project partners to propose specific actions of the Herewear Community, such as participation in other surveys or in pilot initiatives.

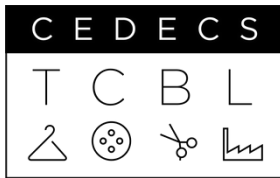
If you provide a special consent, the email address will be used for sending you the project newsletter.

4c) To gather your opinion on a number of issues, which are relevant to our research, which include

- Your priorities for the textile and clothing sectors.



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- Your prioritization of the importance of different Herewear research activities.
- Your interest in possible types of services and initiatives of the Herewear Community.

All opinions you provide through this survey will be treated as commercial in confidence and anonymised prior to publication.

All information will only be treated in aggregate form and never associated to your identity.

5. Legal base of data processing

Your formal consent, as expressed by taking part in this survey and specifically ticking the corresponding boxes, will be the legal basis for processing the aforementioned data and information, wholly or in part.

6. Data processors

The following third party platforms are used for data gathering, processing and storage:

- Survey Monkey, hosted on a secure server located in the US.
- Microsoft Office 365 or equivalent suite, in use at Cedecs-TCBL.
- Microsoft Teams, hosted on a secure server located in Europe.

7. Data recipients

The internal and external staff of the aforementioned partners (see par. 1) based in the European Union and involved in the Herewear project will be entitled to use your data.

8. Data transfers from and to the European Union or the European Economic Area

Survey responses will be downloaded monthly by Cedecs-TCBL and then deleted from surveymonkey.com for additional security.

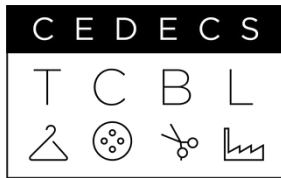
The complete response files will be shared with the organisations in the Herewear project consortium listed in par. 1 above using the internal Microsoft Teams platform.

These organisations include one residing in the UK and another in the US.

These will manage your personal data in accordance with the EU's GDPR.



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9. Retention period of personal data after the survey

Unless a specific request is made to maintain the information, individual survey responses will be destroyed after 5 years from collection.

Anonymised survey data may be added to the Open Access databases of the European Commission.

10. Your rights as data subject

By contacting the Data Controller as specified below, preferably by email, you can exercise the following rights:

- a) To withdraw consent to the storage and processing of data
- b) To obtain confirmation that personal data is being processed and access to it
- c) To obtain rectification of inaccurately reported or incomplete personal data
- d) To obtain the erasure of personal data (“right to be forgotten”)
- e) To object to or obtain restriction of processing
- f) To receive the personal data provided and transmit it to another Controller (“right of data portability”)
- g) To lodge a complaint in case of breaching the data subject’s rights pursuant to applicable law.
